- The **MSU Broad Art Museum** is one of only five international museums designed by Pritzker Architecture Prize-winning architect Zaha Hadid and her first freestanding building in the United States. The MSU Broad Art Museum also has the largest collection of Zaha Hadid Design works in North America.
- The **MSU Libraries** are home to the largest cataloged library collection of comic books in the world.
- The **MSU Museum** is Michigan's first Smithsonian Affiliate.
- **Wharton Center for Performing Arts** is the largest performing arts venue in Michigan, with 2,254 seating capacity in the largest of its two theatres.
- Established in 1873, the **Beal Botanical Garden** is the oldest continuously operated university botanical garden in the United States.
- MSU's **Facility for Rare Isotope Beams**, or FRIB, is the preeminent user facility of its kind globally and home to the world's most powerful heavy-ion accelerator. FRIB regularly partners with the arts across campus to create experiences at the nexus of arts and sciences that can only happen at MSU.
- **Over 400 MSU students** representing almost every college at the university work in paid, mentored internships with university arts spaces each year.
